## **Accident Reporting**

Colleagues,

Within my role as GMB National Health & Safety representative for ASDA London Region I visit many stores and am concerned upon the number of accidents which are brought to my attention which have not been reported.



During the last GMB National Health & Safety forum meeting, which I attended in Leeds with ASDA's senior compliance and Health & Safety managers, I was told that accidents across ASDA's stores had reduced however RIDDOR's had increased.

Simply put "Accidents are not being reported"

ASDA's Accident Reporting and Investigating Policy states that <u>ALL</u> accidents must be reported however colleagues are being informed that it is "<u>Optional</u>" and it is "<u>Your Choice</u>". However, there is a <u>LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO REPORT AND INVESTIGATE ACCIDENTS.</u>

If ALL accidents and near misses were investigated the result would be a safer environment within your workplace and you would see more serious accidents declining.

If you are aware of any accident within your workplace, please report immediately to a manager and request the accident is investigated.
